

# North Allegheny Middle School Cross Country Invitational – 2026

**Date:** Tuesday, October 13, 2026 (rain date: Wednesday, Oct. 14)

**Place:** Marshall Middle School      5145 Wexford Run Road,      Wexford, PA 15090

**Event Schedule:** (Approximate times. We will begin each race once the previous one is finished. Teams should arrive prior to the first race in case schedule alteration is made necessary by weather conditions.)

**Note:** Teams should plan on arriving in time for the Select races even if they are only entered in the open races. In case of inclement weather, there is a chance that we will condense all girls into one race and all boys into another. If the races are condensed, we will score it without distinguishing between select and open. Top 25 finishers will receive top 25 medals regardless of the race in which they were originally entered. Ribbons will follow from there with select ribbons going first and open ones following.

**Course:** The course is 1.8 miles, mostly grass with a small amount of asphalt (when crossing a road twice).

**Scoring:** The first 5 runners per team score and the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> runners displace in the "Select" races. (No team scoring in the "Open" races.)

**Team Awards:** Team trophies go to top three teams in the "Select" races. Combined trophy to team with lowest combined (boys and girls) score.

**Individual Awards:** "Select" Races – top 25 will receive medals, 26-75 will receive ribbons.  
"Open" Races – top 75 will receive ribbons.

**Entries:** "Select" Races – Each school may enter one team consisting of 5-7 runners.  
"Open" Races – Schools can enter an unlimited amount of runners.  
**Note:** Schools with fewer than five runners may enter the "Select" Race but will not score.

**Entry Fees:** \$100.00 per school for boys. \$100.00 per school for girls. \$200.00 per school for both. We can no longer accept entries other than at the full team rate regardless of the number of runners.

# Parking for NA Invitational

In order to somewhat alleviate parking issues, buses are going to be parked off-site at the Covenant Community Church (5157 Wexford Run Road, Wexford, PA 15090) after dropping off their teams. The church is located immediately on the other side of the bridge over I-79, a few hundred yards from the Marshall campus. Bus drivers can drive back to the campus to pick up the teams when they are ready to depart. The church is indicated on the map below in blue. In case we miss you upon arrival, please let your drivers know of this arrangement.

Also, for spectators hoping to avoid congestion driving onto the campus, especially between 3:00 and 3:40 PM, it is recommended that they make use of the rear entrance to campus on Shenot Road. The entrance from Shenot Road is indicated on the map below in red.

The NA JROTC cadets will oversee parking. They will direct spectators to the appropriate locations. They will do their best to maximize the parking that we have available, but some folks might find it more convenient to park off campus or in the church lot with the buses. It is a short walk across the bridge on a sidewalk to the campus from there.
